D.A.R.E. BC's Mission

The D.A.R.E. BC Society is a Canadian registered charity (CRA Registration # 89140 7413 RR0001) whose purpose is to empower the children of British Columbia with the critical thinking and life skills necessary to become safe and responsible citizens. The Society's primary mission is to support the delivery of the RCMP's Drug Abuse Resistance Education (D.A.R.E.) keep'n it REAL (kiR) Program to BC's Grades 5 and 6 school children.

The Society was established over decade ago in the community of Prince George, BC. Since its inception over 100,000 BC school children have taken D.A.R.E., making it the most widely used and comprehensive youth drug prevention program in BC. Over 200 police officers teach D.A.R.E kiR each year to approximately 16,000 Grade 5 or 6 school children in over 100 BC communities. The program is the foundation of the RCMP's Community Prevention Education Continuum a community-lead, police-assisted, comprehensive drug prevention strategy encompassing youth from Kindergarten through to Grade 12.
